

Directive 2002/95/EC, Restriction of the use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical & Electronic Equipment (RoHS).

As Monitoring and Control Equipment is specifically excluded from the ROHS Directive, Extronics Ltd have no legal obligation to comply with this directive with respect to equipment that we build. However, it is our intention to comply with the spirit of the directive where possible by minimising the use of hazardous substance in the manufacture of our products. In addition, we have taken steps to ensure that equipment for other purposes provided by our third-party suppliers is in compliance with this directive where appropriate.

Directive 2002/96/EC, Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE).

Having obtained advice from the DTI web site, Extronics Ltd have determined that, since the equipment we build is invariably part of another or a fixed installation, it does not fall within the requirements of the WEEE Directive. We have taken steps to ensure that equipment bought from our third-party suppliers and sold on as non-fixed equipment is in compliance with this directive where appropriate.
